ATLANTA – Tampa Bay's three-game winning streak against the Falcons came to an end as the Buccaneers opened their 2006 road schedule with a loss in Atlanta. The Falcons churned out 306 rushing yards, the most ever surrendered by a Buccaneers defense. For Tampa Bay, WR Joey Galloway tied his career high with nine receptions for 161 yards, the second-highest total of his career. Additionally, QB Chris Simms passed for a career-high 313 yards, the first 300-yard passing day of his career. Following a missed field goal by Tampa Bay and a pass interference penalty deep in Buccaneers territory, Atlanta took a 7-0 lead on a QB Michael Vick one-yard touchdown run. CB DeAngelo Hall's interception and return in Tampa Bay territory set up Atlanta's second score of the day as Vick found FB Fred McCrary on a four-yard touchdown pass for a 14-0 Falcons lead midway through the second quarter. Tampa Bay drove to the Atlanta four-yard line just before halftime, but had to settle for a 22-yard field goal by K Matt Bryant. Tampa Bay again had a chance to cut into the lead on the first drive of the second half, but Simms was intercepted at the Atlanta goal line. On Atlanta's ensuing possession, LB Derrick Brooks intercepted Vick and returned it 63 yards for a touchdown. However, the score was nullified because of an illegal block penalty on the return. The Buccaneers could not capitalize on the turnover as Bryant missed a 43-yard field goal. Following Falcons K Michael Koenen's fourth missed field goal of the day, including one blocked kick, Tampa Bay again threatened to break the goal line but Simms' deep pass to Galloway was intercepted by Hall late in the fourth quarter.

TAMPA – Tampa Bay erased a 17-point first half deficit, but K John Kasay's 46-yard field goal with two seconds remaining lifted the Panthers. QB Chris Simms accounted for one touchdown passing and one rushing, and DE Simeon Rice led the defensive effort as he recorded four tackles, including one sack, and two forced fumbles. Carolina wasted no time getting on the scoreboard after Simms was intercepted on his first pass attempt, and on the next play, Panthers QB Jake Delhomme found WR Keyshawn Johnson for a 31-yard touchdown reception. NEW ORLEANS – Saints rookie RB Reggie Bush's 65-yard punt return for a touchdown with 4:17 remaining in the game proved to be the difference. The Buccaneers offense racked up 406 total yards and for the second game in a row rallied from a deficit of 10 or more points to take a late lead. Making his first career start, rookie QB Bruce Gradkowski completed 20-of-31 pass attempts for 225 yards and two touchdowns while Carnell 'Cadillac' Williams recorded his first 100-yard rushing performance of the season. After a 34-yard run by Williams to the Saints six-yard line, Tampa Bay recaptured the lead as Gradkowski found TE Alex Smith for a three-yard TD pass and a 21-17 lead with 10:03 remaining. Tampa Bay regained possession with 6:16 left in the contest, but failed to gain a first down, setting up Bush's game deciding score. The offense was driving with less than four minutes to play as Gradkowski found WR Ike Hilliard deep in Saints territory, but an offensive pass interference penalty was called on Galloway.

Set up by a 38-yard run by RB Carnell ‘Cadillac’ Williams, Tampa Bay got on the board on its first drive of the second half as Gradkowski found TE Alex Smith from two yards out to tie the game at 7-7. Cincinnati regained the lead on the following drive as K Shayne Graham hit a 37-yard field goal for a 10-7 lead. Graham tacked on another field goal early in the fourth quarter to push the Bengals lead to 13-7. Taking possession for the final time at the Tampa Bay 46-yard line with 4:21 remaining in the game, Gradkowski led the Buccaneers on a nine-play, 54-yard game-winning drive. TAMPA – In one of the most thrilling games in team history, K Matt Bryant connected on a 62-yard FG with no time remaining for the win. The 62-yard FG was the second longest game-winning field goal in NFL history and the third longest overall. Tampa Bay did not commit a turnover while forcing four Eagles turnovers as Buccaneers CB Ronde Barber became the first player in team history to return two interceptions for touchdowns in the same game during the regular season, taking two QB Donovan McNabb pass attempts back from 37 and 66 yards for scores. Barber put Tampa Bay up 7-0 early in the second quarter on his first interception return for a touchdown. Philadelphia threatened before halftime, driving to the six-yard line, but bypassed a FG attempt with eight seconds remaining for a shot at the end zone, which failed when TE L.J. Smith was tackled at the two-yard line by Barber after a short pass from McNabb. The Buccaneers extended the lead to 10-0 on the first drive of the second half as Bryant connected on a 30-yard FG. On the Eagles ensuing possession, Barber recorded his second interception return for a touchdown and a 17-0 lead. The Eagles responded on their next drive as McNabb found FB Thomas Tapeh on a 12-yard TD pass. McNabb brought the Eagles to within three points at 17-14, finding WR Reggie Brown for a seven-yard TD pass. Tampa Bay pushed the lead to 20-14 on its next drive on Bryant's second FG of the day, a 44-yarder. Philadelphia began its final possession of the game with 2:49 remaining and drove near midfield. McNabb found RB Brian Westbrook on a short pass over the middle, which Westbrook turned into a 52-yard TD after breaking numerous tackles. Tampa Bay started the final drive on its own 36-yard line with 27 seconds remaining. Following a reception by WR Michael Clayton and a nine-yard scramble by QB Bruce Gradkowski, Bryant connected on his historic FG as time expired.

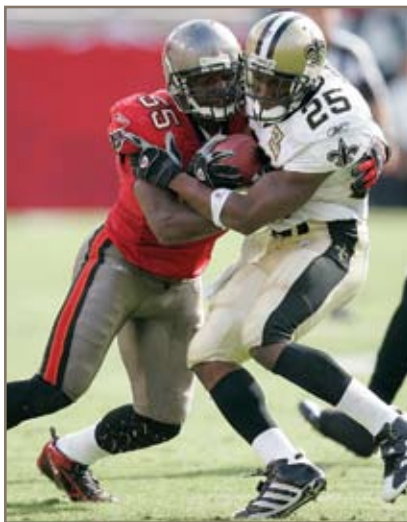

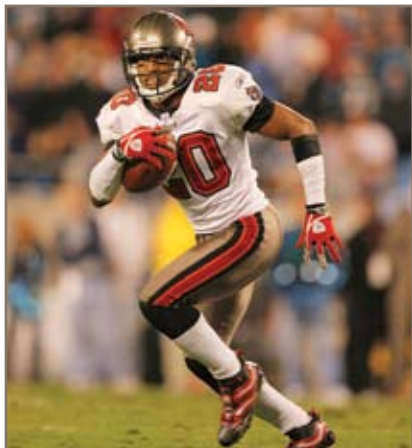

Late in the third quarter, the Buccaneers threatened again, driving to the Steelers four-yard line before Gradkowski was intercepted in the end zone by CB Bryant McFadden. On the ensuing possession, Pittsburgh drove 80 yards in five plays as Roethlisberger found TE Heath Miller for a 16-yard touchdown pass and a 17-0 lead. Following Pittsburgh's third interception of Gradkowski, the Steelers pushed the lead to 20-0 on K Jeff Reed's 39-yard field goal with 1:56 remaining in the game. Tampa Bay got on the board on the final play as K Matt Bryant hit a 27-yard field goal. In the contest, LB Derrick Brooks intercepted the 23rd pass of his career to move into a tie for fifth place all-time in team history.

CHICAGO – Trailing by 21 points late in the third quarter, Tampa Bay rallied to tie the game and force overtime, but K Robbie Gould's 25-yard field goal with 3:37 remaining in the extra frame won it for the Bears. Buccaneers QB Tim Rattay replaced starting QB Bruce Gradkowski in the second quarter to complete 20-of-35 pass attempts for 268 yards, a career-high tying three TDs and one interception as he helped erase the 21-point deficit. Chicago managed the only points of the first quarter as QB Rex Grossman hit TE Desmond Clark on a 24-yard TD reception. Tampa Bay cut the lead to 7-3 on K Matt Bryant's 45-yard FG midway through the second quarter, but the Bears scored touchdowns on two of their next three drives, including a five-yard scoring run by former Buccaneer RB Thomas Jones and another Grossman to Clark touchdown pass from 12 yards. Chicago pushed its lead to 24-3 with 5:22 remaining in the third quarter, but Tampa Bay's offense came to life on the next possession as FB Mike Alstott brought the Buccaneers within 14 on his 14-yard TD run. Bears KR Devin Hester fumbled the ensuing kickoff and LB Wesly Mallard recovered for Tampa Bay on the Chicago 16-yard line. Three plays later, Rattay found TE Alex Smith for a nine-yard TD, cutting the lead to 24-17 with 14:13 remaining in the contest. Chicago went back up by 14 on its next possession as RB Cedric Benson scored from four yards out. Tampa Bay again trimmed the lead to seven on the next drive as Rattay hit WR Joey Galloway over the middle and he outraced two Bears defenders for a 64-yard TD. The Bucs defense forced a Bears three-and-out on their next possession and two plays later, Rattay hit WR Ike Hilliard on a short slant, which he turned into a 44-yard TD to tie the game at 31-31 and force overtime. Following a fumble by Smith on the opening drive of the extra frame, Chicago missed the potential game-winning FG from 37 yards. On their next drive after a Buccaneers punt, Grossman hit WR Rashied Davis for a questionable 28-yard reception on third down as replays showed the ball hitting the ground, though it was never reviewed by replay officials. Three plays later, Gould connected on the game-winner.
