2017 TRAINING CAMP

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Glass Bottles, Cans
 - Bottled water, metal or plastic re-useable water bottles are permitted.
 - Medically-required dietary items in small soft-sided coolers are permitted.
- Backpacks, duffel bags, large bags, hard containers and cooler, Thermoses, camera bags/Binocular cases.
 - Clear Diaper bags permitted.
 - Clear bags permitted
 - Clear, small Soft sided coolers are permitted
 - All permitted bags and containers must meet the size requirements set by the Buccaneers
- Alcoholic beverages
- Drugs and narcotics (except for prescription medication or other medically necessary over the counter medications)
- Signs, Banners, or flags with sticks or poles; items that could obstruct view
- Video cameras and Cameras with a lens longer than 6 inches (includes body, lens and filter)
- Artificial noisemakers (air horns, bullhorns, whistles, vuvuzelas, etc.)
- Items that could be missiles or projectiles
- Lasers
- Pets (except medically necessary service animals)
- Recreational balls and equipment of any type
 - Football and memorabilia for autographs are permitted
- Skates, skateboards, skate-shoes, all cycles and Segways unless medically necessary
- Full size strollers
 - Collapsible strollers are allowed
- Open and/or large umbrellas or anything that could obstruct view
 - Collapsible umbrellas allowed
- Weapons/fireworks
- Obscene or indecent clothing or signs
- Sticks/Poles/ "Selfie" Sticks
- Unmanned Aircraft Systems & Radio Controlled Model Aircraft/Drones
- Bags not conforming to the NFL Bag policy. (Clear and clutch)

PROHIBITED CONDUCT

- Use of tobacco products or e-cigarettes (except in designated locations)
- Fighting, taunting, threatening remarks or gestures.
- Abusive, foul or disruptive language or obscene gestures.
- Intoxication or signs of impairment related to alcohol consumption or drug use
- Disruption of Practice

- Throwing, projecting, or kicking objects in the stands or playing areas
- Running or jogging
- Failing to follow instructions of Buccaneers or security personnel
- Standing or sitting in walkways.
- Entering Camp with weapons of any kind.
- Distributing handbills, pamphlets, products, etc., unless authorized by the Buccaneers.
- Sampling of goods or unauthorized collections of any kind on Bucs property
- Displays of affection not appropriate in a public setting
- The display of obscene or indecent clothing or signs
- Behavior which otherwise interferes with other guests' enjoyment
- Operating Unmanned Aircraft Systems & Radio Controlled Model Aircraft.
- Use of speakerphones or music without a headset
- Skateboarding, biking, or the use of other wheeled devices unless medically necessary
- Any other conduct that is prohibited by the Buccaneers in their sole discretion.
